- Submit all required documents to Undergraduate Admissions, 1600 Holloway Ave., SF, CA 94132 by **February 12, 2010**. Transcripts must include Fall 2009 grades, if appropriate.

1. GPA: Overall GPA of at least 3.2; prerequisite GPA of at least 3.2
2. Prerequisites: prerequisite courses or equivalents, completed or in progress: BIO 210/211, MATH 124, PSY 200, DFM 253
3. Experience: see next page
4. Professional Goals: see next page
5. Writing skills: based on personal statement; see next page
6. Overall application: proper completion of application and directions followed (please do not use folders)
