DEADLINES FOR APPLICATIONS

New Transfer Students:

- Submit official San Francisco State University application (<http://www.csumentor.edu>) by **November 30, 2009**.
- Submit all documents to complete SFSU application to Undergraduate Admissions, 1600 Holloway Ave, S.F., CA 94132 by **February 12, 2010**. Transcripts must include Fall 2009 grades. (Do **not** submit transcripts to CFS/D Department.)
- Submit the Supplemental Program Application to the CFS/D Department by **March 1, 2010**. (No ID application will be considered if SFSU application is incomplete.)

Current SFSU Students (Sophomores, Juniors, Seniors):

- Submit ID Supplemental Program Application to CFS/D Department with unofficial SFSU transcripts with Fall grades by **March 1, 2010**. (Applications accepted only between **January 4-March 1, 2010**).

CRITERIA FOR EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

1. **Upper Division Status:** you must have earned at least 60 units before Fall
2. **GPA:** Overall College GPA of at least 2.5
3. **Prerequisites:** prerequisite courses completed or in progress: ADM 260, ID 240, ID 242, a college level drawing class
4. **Professional Goals** (see details below)
5. **Writing Skills** (based on personal statement; see details below)
6. **Qualifying Design Project** (see details below and p.4)
7. **Overall Presentation:** proper completion of application and directions followed.

REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS TO SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATION (put name on each page)

1. **Personal Statement of Professional Goals:** Your personal statement should be a *one page* (maximum), typed statement. Describe your professional goals related to the interior design program. Put your name on the statement and attach it to this application with other required items. All information is confidential and is used only to evaluate your application.
2. **Qualifying Design Project:** See p. 4 for directions
Projects must be picked from the CFS/D office by **March 22, 2010**. Otherwise they will be discarded. Sorry, projects cannot be returned by mail.
3. **Unofficial SFSU transcripts including Fall semester** (current SFSU students only)
4. **Computer printouts** from www.assist.org of articulated prerequisite courses. (See p.3 for details)
5. **College Catalog Course descriptions of transferred course**, if applicable (See p.4 for details)

Emails will be sent to applicants approximately two weeks after submission deadline. Applicants will receive official letters of notification from the university Admissions Office.

Qualifying Design Project (Fall 2010)

CONTENTS: Project drawings should be 17x22 and mounted on matboard and submitted **only** inside a recyclable corrugated cardboard protective cover (no tubes will be accepted), not to exceed 20x26, with name and contact information on the outside. Using the floor plan below, create a set of hand-drafted design drawings.

- Maintain the footprint size and room types (i.e., bedroom or bathroom), but reconfigure interior space by changing location of interior walls, fireplace, windows, and/or fixtures. Not all spaces must be reconfigured.
- Each item must include a drawing title with scale (if applicable) below it and your name on the back of each board.

Include the following:

1. Dimensioned Floor Plan with furniture layout in 1/4" scale
2. A Lighting/Electrical Plan and Legend on a separate board also in 1/4" scale
3. Four Interior Elevations of one room, or two walls of two rooms, with design features, drawn at 1/2" scale
4. One color-rendered one-point or two-point perspective drawing of any room design. This must be rendered by hand, not computer-generated.

ASSESSMENT: Projects will be evaluated by SFSU Interior Design faculty. Passes in all of the following areas are needed for an overall Pass on the qualifying design project.

1. Accuracy of drawings
2. Quality of hand drafting and space planning
3. Quality of end design and color use
4. Quality of color rendering
5. Overall presentation of labeled project boards
